ORDER

Whereas, the services of employees of SAS Cadre are governed by the provisions of service rules titled as "Haryana State Subordinate Accounts (Group-C) Service Rules, 1982" which have been repealed by the Service Rules titled as "Haryana State Subordinate Accounts (Group-C) Service Rules, 2013". The modes of recruitment have been mentioned in these service rules, which are reproduced as under:-

Rule	Title of service rules	Provision
7(1)	Haryana State Subordinate Accounts (Group-C) Service Rules, 1982	Recruitment to the service shall be made by promotion from amongst the candidates who have passed both parts of the Haryana State Subordinate Accounts Services Examination (Ordinary Branch) conducted by the Government.
9 (1)	Haryana State Subordinate Accounts (Group-C) Service Rules, 2013	Recruitment to the service in the case of Section Officer shall be made – (i) 30% by direct recruitment; and (ii) 70% by promotion; or (iii) By transfer/deputation an official already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India.

Whereas, on the request of employees of Haryana State Boards/Corporations, it was decided by the Government vide letter No.14/59/93-1FA, dated 17.5.1995 to absorb the employees working in the State Boards/Corporations who passed SAS Part-I and II examination of Haryana State for appointment as Section Officer. The said decision was taken in relaxation of Rule-5 Appendix B of Haryana State Subordinate Accounts (Group-C) Service Rules, 1982. Those employees can appear in SAS examination who have atleast three years ministerial regular satisfactory service with educational qualification of Graduation.

Whereas, some Section Officers approached the Punjab and Haryana High Court by way of CWP No.18370 of 2009 – Subh Karan Sharma and others Vs State of Haryana, for counting their past service rendered by them in Boards/Corporations before their selection in SAS cadre for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits. The said writ petition was allowed vide order dated 27.5.2010 by the Punjab and Haryana High Court with a direction to respondents to consider the service rendered by the petitioners in the Haryana State Minor Irrigation Tubewells Corporation for all intents and purposes, except seniority. It was further directed that the grant of pensionary/retiral benefits shall be subject to deposit of CPF contribution, gratuity etc. in accordance with the rules by the petitioners. LPA No.1261 of 2011 was decided on 18.08.2011 in favour of petitioners with one modification i.e. previous service shall be
